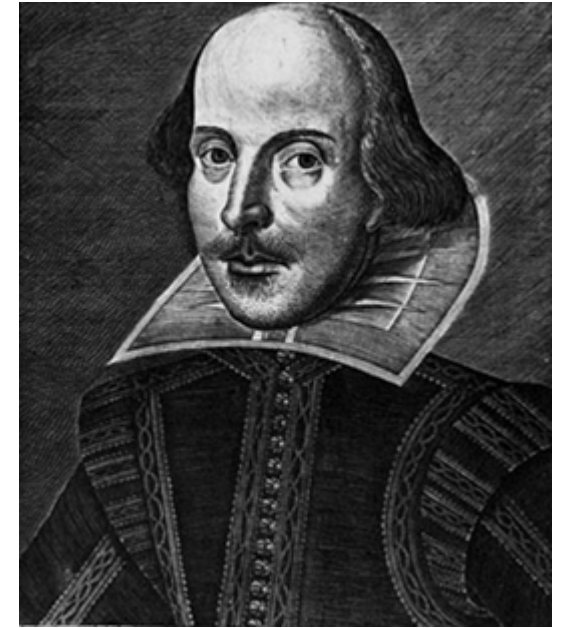

Dr. Stephen Smith and his wife Laura have three sons, William, Nicholas, and Thomas, and have lived in Hillsdale, Michigan, for the past ten years.

Steve holds degrees in the great books and English Renaissance literature from the University of Notre Dame and the University of Dallas, and he has taught the Great Books and English Renaissance literature at Hillsdale College since 2001. In 2008, he was named *Virginia Townley Chair of English Literature*.

His areas of expertise are the plays of William Shakespeare and the life and writings of Sir Thomas More, the great Renaissance statesman, scholar, and saint.

He is co-editor of *A Thomas More Sourcebook* (CUA Press) and *Shakespeare's Last Plays: Readings in Literature and Politics*, and he is author of the forthcoming *Shakespeare as Teacher: Wonder, Art, and the Education of Leaders in the Late Plays of William Shakespeare*.

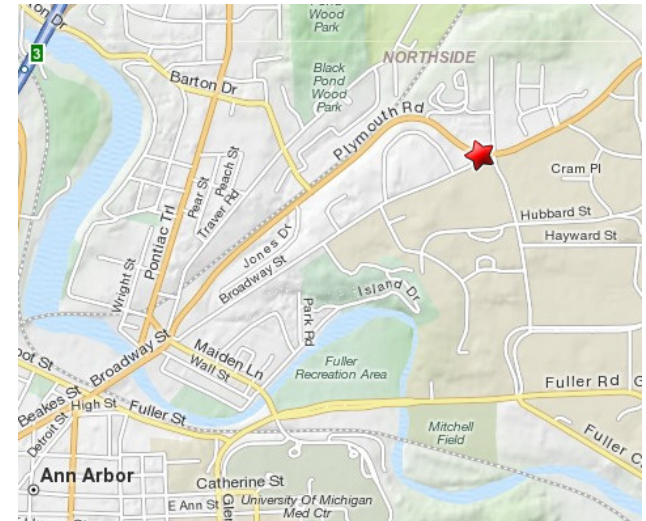
